- 1 The originating application made by the Applicants on 6 December 2019 was determined by Justice Lang on 10 December 2019.
- 2 The determination was made without a hearing.
- 3 The following orders were made:
  - 3.1 The Applicants are allowed to commence this proceeding by way of originating application.
  - 3.2 The period of time in which the Applicants are required under section 32(1)(b) of the Receiverships Act 1993 to give notice of the termination of a contract of employment is extended until Friday 29 May 2020 in respect of the following companies in receivership:
    - (a) Claymark Limited (In Receivership); and
    - (b) Profiles Woodproducts Limited (In Receivership).
  - 3.3 Leave is granted to any employee who seeks to have the order overturned to apply to the Court for such an order.
