- **2.** The ancillary orders were made upon reading:
 - the second affidavit of Neale Jackson in support of the applicants' originating application without notice, affirmed on 11 November 2016; and

 - (b) that the Period be extended to 8 February 2017, being the date by which the Watershed Meeting must be held pursuant to s 239AV of the Act, because the convening period has been extended to 31 January 2017;

 - (i) posting notice on the website www.kordamentha.com; and
 - (ii) sending a copy of the ancillary orders to each employee to the employee's email address by which Wynyard currently communicates with each employee;

- (d) the Court file in this proceeding shall be marked and treated as confidential and shall not be available for search by any person until 8 February 2017;
- (e) leave is granted to any employee to apply to modify or discharge these orders within 5 working days of service.
