ORDER OF THE COURT

- 1 The application made by the applicants on 19 August 2020 was determined by Justice Campbell on 19 August 2020.
- 2 The determination was made without a hearing.
- 3 The following orders are made:
 - 3.1 the period of time in which the applicants are required under s 32(1)(b) of the Receiverships Act 1993 (the *Act*) to give notice of the termination of contracts of employment in respect of Claymark Limited (In Receivership) and Profiles Woodproducts Limited (In Receivership) (the *Companies*) is extended until 30 November 2020;
 - 3.2 leave is granted to any employee of the Companies who seeks to have the order overturned to apply to the Court for such an order; and
 - 3.3 the Court file will be sealed and the Court will require a hearing before any party can view the Court's file (subject to any contrary provision in the High Court Rules and/or the Senior Courts (Access to Court Documents) Rules 2017).
