TO: Employees of Trev Terry Marine Limited (in receivership)
(Company).

1. The originating application made on a without notice basis by Natalie Gytha Burrett and Neale Jackson (**Applicants**) on 6 March 2024 was determined by the Honourable Justice Powell on 6 March 2024.
2. The determination was made without a hearing.
3. The following orders were made:
 - (a) the period of time within which notice of termination of employment contracts is required to be given by the Applicants to employees of the Company under section 32(1)(b) of the Receiverships Act 1993 (Act) be extended to 19 April 2024, being 42 days after the expiry of the fourteenth day after the Applicants were appointed as receivers of the Company; and
 - (b) employees of the Company shall be notified of the grant of the order in paragraph 3(a) above by email from the Receivers within three working days after the orders are granted; and
 - (c) employees of the Company are granted leave to challenge the orders on notice to the Applicants.
